Departure begins at 7:00 A.M. from Harding’s Market Place, 6330 South Westnedge Ave (one mile South of I-94) in Portage, Michigan. Our first stop on the tour will be to **DeBrand Fine Chocolates Factory**. The tour will take you behind the scenes and show you their chocolate-making process through their three kitchens and we will enjoy several samples along the way. Lunch will be on your own at **Zaharakos Ice Cream Parlour**. This parlour dates back to 1900 and features a museum where you can learn all about soda fountains and mechanical music. Upon arrival in Louisville, Kentucky we will take a tour of the **Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory**. Baseball fanatic or not this tour is fascinating! We will watch the bat-making from start to finish and receive a free miniature Louisville Slugger bat at the end. Our home for the evening will be the **Fairfield Inn & Suites in downtown Louisville**. Dinner will be included at **Captain’s Quarters Riverside Grill** with your choice of a famous Kentucky Hot Brown or a Fire-Braised Beef Brisket. The rest of the evening is yours to explore the city.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2017

Good Morning! Be sure to bring your cameras this morning because we are going to get an once-in-a-lifetime chance to spend the morning trackside and behind the scenes at **Churchill Downs Racetrack**. You will enjoy breakfast while watching the horses during their morning workouts. Admission to the **Kentucky Derby Museum** is also included in the tour. After the tour we will make our way South and stop for an included lunch at **Stephen Foster Restaurant**. Following lunch we will take a tour through **Maker’s Mark Distillery** to see their aging process, their famous

trademarked dipped red wax seal and taste samples. Our next stop is **Mammoth Cave**. We will depart by bus and journey over the top of the cave to the Frozen Niagara Entrance and learn about the cave's formation and history. Our home for the evening is the **Drury Inn in Bowling Green**, Kentucky. Here a FREE Kickback meal and drinks will be provided by the hotel.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2017

Breakfast is included at the hotel prior for departure to the **National Corvette Museum**. We will spend time perusing the iconic American sports car, the Chevrolet Corvette which has been in production since 1953 and hear the tragic story of how a sinkhole in the museum swallowed eight classic cars back in 2014. Lunch will be on your own today before a step on guide joins us on our motor coach for a **"Folk Arts and Craft, Capitol of Kentucky"** tour. This tour will include us driving through Berea College and learning history of the college and the town and a stop at the Log House Craft Gallery, home to student crafts. Following the tour we will check in to our hotel for the evening, **The Boone Tavern at Berea**. Also included tonight at the hotel will be dinner and a show!

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2017

After our continental breakfast at the Tavern we will make our way to Lexington, Kentucky. Upon arrival to the Kentucky Horse Park a step on guide will join us on our motor coach for a tour of a signature **Thoroughbred Horse Farm**, a tour of **Old Friends Thoroughbred Retirement Farm**, and a **driving tour through Historic Downtown Lexington & Countryside**. Following the conclusion of the tour, time will be given at the **Kentucky Horse Park** for lunch on your own in the cafeteria and to view the **International Museum of the Horse** at the park. Once we leave the horse park we will get the chance to watch a fall horse racing at **Keeneland Racetrack**. We will see many Breeders' Cup-bound stars prep at Keeneland as a prelude to the World Championships. The day is not over yet. This evening we will take a cruise on the **Ohio River aboard B&B Riverboats for a Captains Dinner Cruise**. Our hotel for the evening will be the **Hampton Inn near Cincinnati, Ohio**.
